<u>Education</u> - Jeannie reported \$0 spent in First Quarter. Presenters are upping their prices and not travelling. Fortunately, there are many good Zoom offerings which have attracted large audiences.

<u>**Teaching Garden**</u> The Board approved funding for the Porta Potty. The monthly cost of \$205 includes weekly service of the handicapped accessible unit. Leslie hopes it will be installed March 28/29.

Tuesday morning TG workdays will begin 3/29; Thursday evening hours begin 4/7 and Saturday morning begin 4/16. MG volunteers are asked to work at least 2 hours each year in the Teaching Garden.

The Plant Sale will be May 14<sup>th</sup>. Donated plants must be washed and placed in new potting soil to help control the spread of invasive jumping worms.

<u>VMGA</u> The Board approved Jeanne's request of \$50 for paper products for the April VGMA meeting that MGPW is co-hosting.

<u>VCE</u> Nancy reported 146 attendees at ReCert.

Christina is working hard to get Better Impact up- dated. Clinic sign up hours will be available.

The Board discussed reviving the MGPW Diversity Committee with a goal of reaching underserved populations in PWC. Plans are being made for Ask a Gardener tables at HMart and ToDos. Patrick has agreed to lead.

<u>Additional reports</u> Jeannie will send an announcement to Maria Stewart for the Newsletter regarding MGPW scholarships to VMG College. One scholarship of \$200 for registration is available.

Patrick will organize Zoom meetings for the Board.

Janene will send a President's Message to the County Supervisors as well as the MGPW Newsletter.
